At the June 23, 2025 Regular Board of Education Meeting, Board of Education member Ranae Erickson resigned from her seat as a board trustee. The term of the vacated board seat expires on December 31, 2026.

Candidates interested in applying for the vacant seat on the Board of Education must submit in writing his or her full name, address, and indicate why he or she is interested, what he or she hopes to bring to the Board table, and any other information the current 6 board members should know about the candidate. To be eligible for the vacant board seat, a person must:

- Be a qualified school elector (registered voter within Holton Public Schools boundaries)
- Have a primary residence in Holton Public Schools boundaries
- Be at least 18 years of age
- Be a citizen of the United States
- Be a resident of the state of Michigan for at least 30 days.

The Board will meet and appoint a candidate to fill the vacancy on July 21, 2025 at a Special Board Meeting 5:00 pm.
