- 2. Establish and maintain high expectations for student effort and conduct.

3. Provide a balanced program aligned with state and local curriculum standards that will meet the academic, social, emotional, and behavioral needs of students.

- 4. Communicate with families regarding the students' academic, social, and behavioral progress.
- 5. Welcome parents and guardians to participate in activities, programs, and projects.
- 6. Design and implement a plan for two-way communication with parents of their students.

7. Design teaching and learning episodes that are engaging and support student efforts to become better readers, writers, and problem solvers.
